The Landscape master's program aims to form **experts in landscape design and planning**, in order to work in multidisciplinary teams. Free space, defined by a social context as well as a physical one, which is directly subjected to environmental factors, has to be more than just functionally adequate and visually stimulating: it also has to satisfy aesthetic and ecological requirements. The program takes place with the collaboration of experts in the fields of environmental and human sciences, landscape planning and design and it is supported by research activities developed at different departments in the polytechnic university in direct relationship with local administrations. The program is developed during two academic years, on Thursday and Friday afternoons. The intensive international course is developed during two weeks in fulltime sessions. The dissertation seminar takes place within the last term, in addition to the normal schedule hours.
